Operated out of Southern Connecticut State
University's Center for Adaptive Technology, this
loan program helps students with disabilities get
the assistive technology and adaptive software they
need. We do this by giving every Connecticut school
the opportunity to borrow a laptop or iPad for students
with disabilities. Technology can be borrowed for any
number of reasons including evaluations, to replace a
computer while one is being repaired, for a trial of the
software or for staff capacity building. Laptops and
iPads are available on a first-come, first-served basis
and can be borrowed for up to four months.
